Teachers communicate with students, parents, colleagues and administrators every day. Whether communicated face-to-face, on the phone, in print, electronically or through the public address system, the message must be constructed carefully and delivered clearly to be properly received. Good handwriting, spelling and grammar are very important in all forms of written communication.

Such a workshop on effective Communication Skills was necessary because teachers need to communicate frequently with parents Although teachers spend most of their working day surrounded

by 20 or more students, they often become flustered when speaking in front of their colleagues at staff meetings or conferences. Communication skills improve with practice, and preparing in advance what to say also helps. Taking a leadership role with other teachers in the school by chairing or co-chairing a committee provides the opportunity to enhance these skills. Communicating with colleagues in this way may be very rewarding and personally fulfilling. It also shows initiative, which can lead to advancement or promotion. Feachers who are skillful communicators have a better chance of being heard by administrators when making a request, such as for a transfer, special leave or permission for a student event or field trip. Good communicators clearly state the reasons for their request, anticipate possible counter-arguments and are prepared to refute them. They control their emotions, don't lose their tempers and always behave in a professional manner, even in disappointing or frustrating situations. Administrators who recognize such efforts are more receptive to granting a positive response to teacher requests.

A Guest lecture was organized on NEP 2020 on 15th September 2021 at 11 am in Hall no 9. The speaker was Prin.Dr.B.S Jagdale from Panchavati College, Nashik. All the senior college teacher and Non Grant teachers attended the lecture. Dr.Mrs.Leena Bhat coordinated the lecture. The speaker discussed following points during the lecture.



NEP 2020: New education policy for higher education ..

- For colleges, the NEP 2020 plans to conduct SAT-like college test. The tests would be conducted by the NTA (National Testing Agency) and that too twice a year.
- The four-year bachelor's course is to be preferred in various disciplines. Students who are midterm dropouts would be given credit for their term they completed and an option to complete their degree after the break.
- Colleges would no longer have an affiliation to the university. The deemed university status will also be ended. Over the next 15 years, the colleges would be given a graded autonomy to provide degrees.
- There is a proposal to cap the fees that are charged by private institutions with respect to higher education.
- 5. Top-rated global universities in the world would be facilitated to company as well as the

top Indian institutes would be encouraged to go global.

- There is a proposal for flexible curriculum, creative combos of subjects, integrated vocational
 education at UG level. Students would also be allowed multiple entries and exit points at the
 UG level.
- The University grants commission would be replaced by the higher education commission of India.
- After a master's degree, there will be no MPhil degree prior to PhD. Students can directly apply for PhD after their masters.

Education policy 2020 PDF key points for college students:

2. NEP has proposed a new curricular with 5+3+3+4 structure. This includes -

3. Five years of the Foundational Stage: 3 years of pre-primary school and Grades 1, 2;

4. Three years of the Preparatory (or Latter Primary) Stage: Grades 3, 4, 5;

5. Three years of the Middle (or Upper Primary) Stage: Grades 6, 7, 8;

6. Four years of the High (or Secondary) Stage: Grades 9, 10, 11, 12.

- 7. Global education access An International Students Office at each institution hosting foreign students will be set up. High-performing Indian universities will be encouraged to set up campuses in other countries. Selected universities like those from among the top 100 universities in the world will be facilitated to operate in India.
- National Research Foundation A National Research Foundation will be established to grant competitive funding for outstanding research proposals across all disciplines.
- Rashtriya Shiksha Aayog The Rashtriya Shiksha Aayog or National Education Commission, headed by the Prime Minister of India. States may set up apex State-level bodies called the Rajya Shiksha Aayog or the State Education Commission.

Teachers communicate with students, parents, colleagues and administrators every day. Whether communicated face-to-face, on the phone, in print, electronically or through the public address system, the message must be constructed carefully and delivered clearly to be properly received. Good handwriting, spelling and grammar are very important in all forms of written communication.

Such a workshop on effective Communication Skills was necessary because teachers need to communicate frequently with parents Although teachers spend most of their working day surrounded by 20 or more students, they often become flustered when speaking in front of their colleagues at staff meetings or conferences. Communication skills improve with practice, and preparing in advance what to say also helps. Taking a leadership role with other teachers in the school by chairing or co-chairing a committee provides the opportunity to enhance these skills. Communicating with colleagues in this way may be very rewarding and personally fulfilling. It also shows initiative, which can lead to advancement or promotion. Teachers who are skillful communicators have a better chance of being heard by administrators when making a request, such as for a transfer, special leave or permission for a student event or field trip. Good communicators clearly state the reasons for their request, anticipate possible counter-arguments and are prepared to refute them. They control their emotions, don't lose their tempers and always behave in a professional manner, even in disappointing or frustrating situations. Administrators who recognize such efforts are more receptive to granting a positive response to teacher requests.



A Guest lecture was organized on NEP 2020 on 15th September 2021 at 11 am in Hall no 9. The speaker was Prin.Dr.B.S Jagdale from Panchavati College, Nashik. All the senior college teacher and Non Grant teachers attended the lecture. Dr.Mrs.Leena Bhat coordinated the lecture. The speaker discussed following points during the lecture.



NEP 2020: New education policy for higher education..

- 1. For colleges, the NEP 2020 plans to conduct SAT-like college test. The tests would be conducted by the NTA (National Testing Agency) and that too twice a year.
- 2. The four-year bachelor's course is to be preferred in various disciplines. Students who are midterm dropouts would be given credit for their term they completed and an option to complete their degree after the break.
- 3. Colleges would no longer have an affiliation to the university. The deemed university status will also be ended. Over the next 15 years, the colleges would be given a graded autonomy to provide degrees.
- 4. There is a proposal to cap the fees that are charged by private institutions with respect to higher education.
- 5. Top-rated global universities in the world would be facilitated to come to India, as well as the


- top Indian institutes would be encouraged to go global.
- 6. There is a proposal for flexible curriculum, creative combos of subjects, integrated vocational education at UG level. Students would also be allowed multiple entries and exit points at the UG level.
- 7. The University grants commission would be replaced by the higher education commission of India
- 8. After a master's degree, there will be no MPhil degree prior to PhD. Students can directly apply for PhD after their masters.

Education policy 2020 PDF key points for college students:

- 1. The PDF can be accessed at the MHRD website that is the ministry of Human Resource & Development website. here is the direct link for education policy PDF https://www.mhrd.gov.in/sites/upload_files/mhrd/files/NEP_Final_English_0.pdf
- 2. NEP has proposed a new curricular with 5+3+3+4 structure. This includes -
- 3. Five years of the Foundational Stage: 3 years of pre-primary school and Grades 1, 2;
- 4. Three years of the Preparatory (or Latter Primary) Stage: Grades 3, 4, 5;
- 5. Three years of the Middle (or Upper Primary) Stage: Grades 6, 7, 8;
- 6. Four years of the High (or Secondary) Stage: Grades 9, 10, 11, 12.
- 7. Global education access An International Students Office at each institution hosting foreign students will be set up. High-performing Indian universities will be encouraged to set up campuses in other countries. Selected universities like those from among the top 100 universities in the world will be facilitated to operate in India.
- 8. National Research Foundation A National Research Foundation will be established to grant competitive funding for outstanding research proposals across all disciplines.
- 9. Rashtriya Shiksha Aayog The Rashtriya Shiksha Aayog or National Education Commission, headed by the Prime Minister of India. States may set up apex State-level bodies called the Rajya Shiksha Aayog or the State Education Commission.
