the year 2018-2019

It gives me great pleasure to present before you. The college has maintained a tradition of success not only inter-varsity but also internationally. Behind this success and our efforts, honorable principal of the college Dr. Ram Kulkarni Sir is also the Secretary of Gokhale Education Institute Sir Dr. M. S. Gosavi sir is our inspiration.

In the year 2018-2019, a total of 18 junior college teams participated in the inter-college competition. Among them, 12 teams such as softball, cricket, football, lawn tennis, judo, baseball, yoga, outdoor competition, carom kick boxing won.

From the national competition held this year

1. Adhirath Gade (Outdoor Event) - 1500m. Represented Maharashtra in the national competition held in Delhi in the sport of running. Also got silver medal in this competition held at Khelo India Pune.
2. Soumit Deshpande ( Table Tennis ) - Represented Maharashtra in the National Tournament held at Gwalior in this sport.
3. Aditya Davre (Cricket) - Represented and captained the Maharashtra team in the national tournament held in Jammu Kashmir.



4. Abhishek Giri (Kick Boxing) - Represented Maharashtra at Dehradun / Uttarakhand at the national level in this martial art sport.

5. Bhavika Vaidya (Swimming) won silver medal in the state competition held at Nagpur.

Similarly, the senior college participated in a total of 24 sports. Among them, they won at the inter-collegiate level in the sports of chess, gymnastics, outdoor competition, fencing, football, cricket (boys) and body building. While Basketball, Football (Boys), Hockey won runners up. This year 4 players were selected for international competition, 8 players were selected for national competition and 13 players were selected for inter-university team.

6. Vigilance Lingayat (Shooting)- Represented the University team for 4 consecutive years in this sport.

7. Amit Maind (Cricket)- Represented Pune University in the inter-university tournament held at Bhubaneswar.

8. Sir Dr. M. S. The Gosavi T20 Cricket Championship is being organized for the 12th time as Sundar in which B.Y.K (X) and Wadia College had a close encounter in which B.Y.K (X) won.

5. Sir Dr. M. S. Gowi T20 Cricket Championship was thought to be beautiful for the 13th time. The semi-final matches will be held today.

It gives me great pleasure to present the report of the Physical Education and Sports Department for the year 2022-2023.

The college has maintained a tradition of success not only inter varsity but also internationally. Behind this success and our efforts, is Dr.VN Suryavanshi Sir, Honorable Principal of the College. Also the secretary of Gokhale Education Institute Sir Dr. M.S. Gosavi sir is our inspiration.

In the year 2022-2023, a total of 26 teams (individual and team sports) of the junior college participated in such inter-collegiate competitions, including sepak takara, cricket (boys/girls), football (boys/girls), karate, cycling, futsal, swimming, 15 teams such as Yoga, Table Tennis, Carrom, Taekwondo, Boxing won. This year, the national competitions could not be held as the government decided to hold all the competitions up to the state level only.



From the state level competition held in the year 2022-2023

1. (Cricket) - In this game held at Dhule, the Under 19 boys team represented Nashik division and confirmed their place for the state level tournament to be held at Palghar.
2. (Table Tennis) – In this sport Sali Vani won gold medals in international competitions in Spain, Germany, Qatar and Maharashtra Olympic Games.
3. (Football) - Winning the district level competition in this sport. Under-19 girls' football team won the runner-up position in the regional tournament held at Dhule.
4. ( Sepak Takara ) – Winning the district level competition in this game. Under 19 girls team won the title in the regional competition held at Jalgaon. He also won a bronze medal in the state level competition held at Satara.
5. Nishigandha Shah – represented Nashik district at Jalgaon at divisional level in (Taekwondo) martial arts sport.
6. Sandesh Mokal (Cycling) - Won silver medal for Nashik division in state level competition held at Aurangabad in this sport.
7. (Futsal) - Winning the district level tournament in this sport. The Under 19 boys team secured their spot in the regional tournament to be held at Baramati.



8. Two athletes represented the Maharashtra team in Khelo India and Maharashtra Olympic Games.

Similarly, the senior college participated in a total of 23 sports. They have won at the inter-collegiate level in the sports of chess, gymnastics, field competition, fencing, football, cricket (boys/girls) and shooting. While Basketball, Football (Boys) achieved runners-up.
