The availability of subjects are such that they are relevant to changing economic environment. The students understand that they get optimum advantages of these subjects in their career growth which has reflected in the above graph.

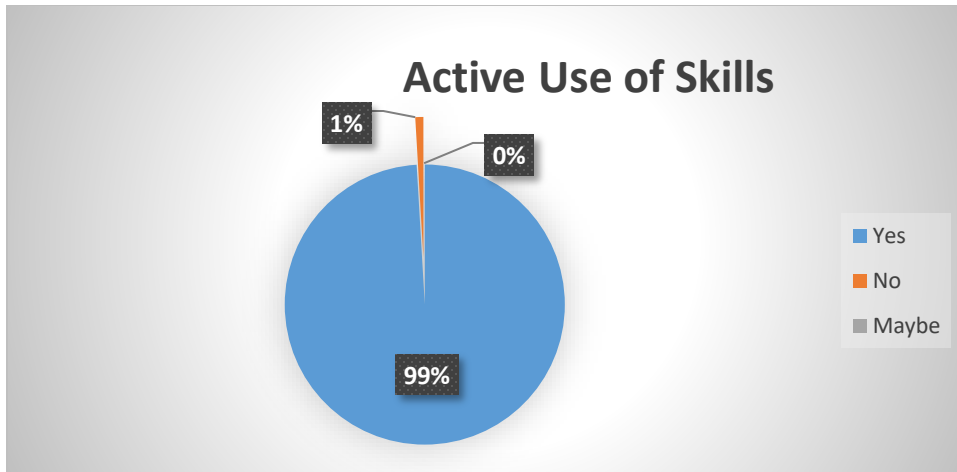

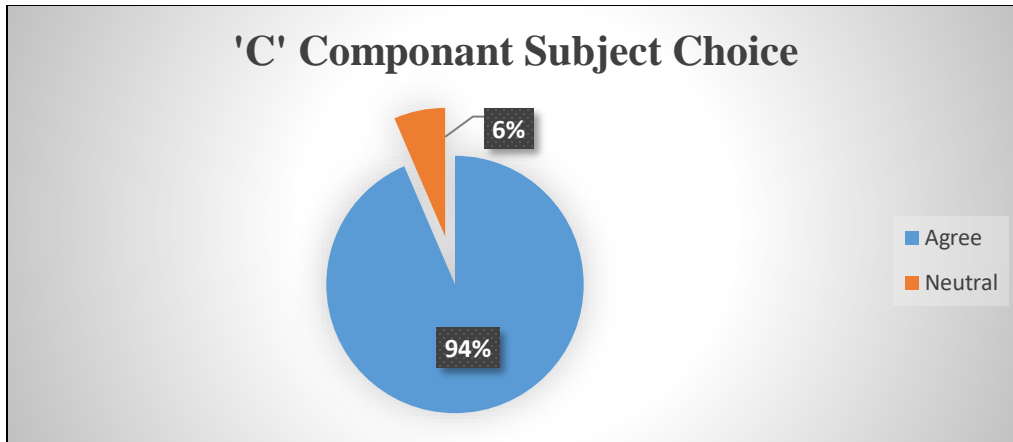

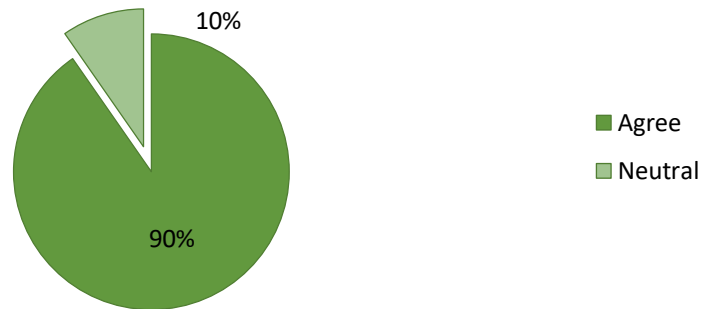

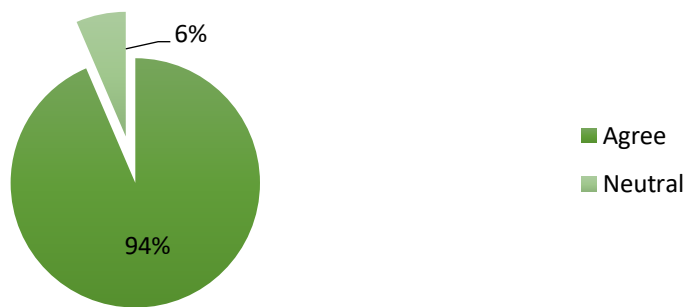

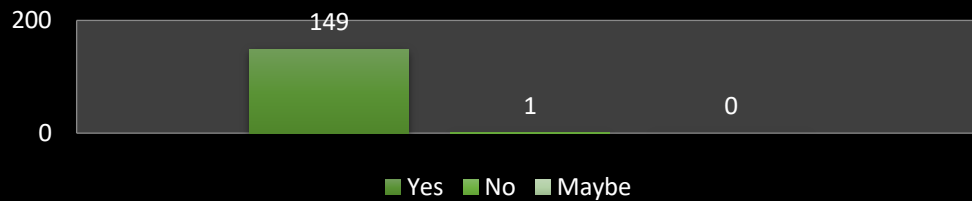

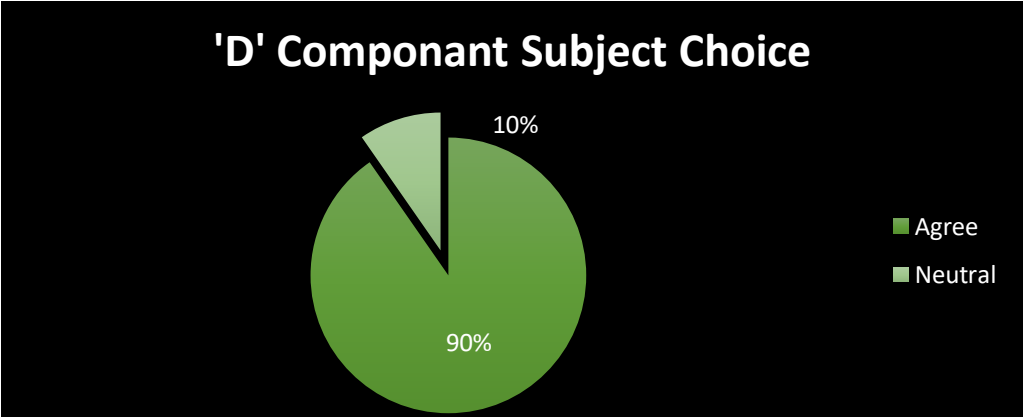
12. Parent's feedback on Academic Performance

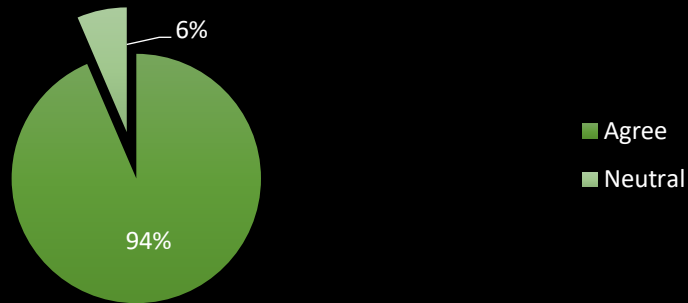

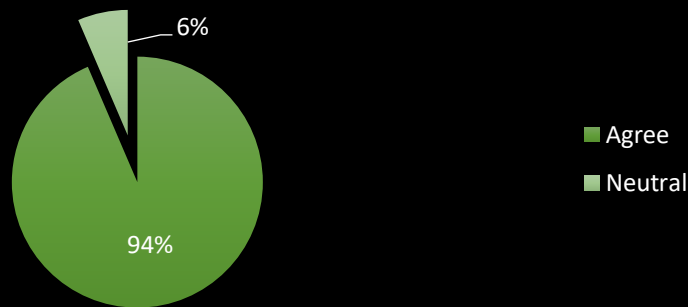


'C' Component Subject Choice



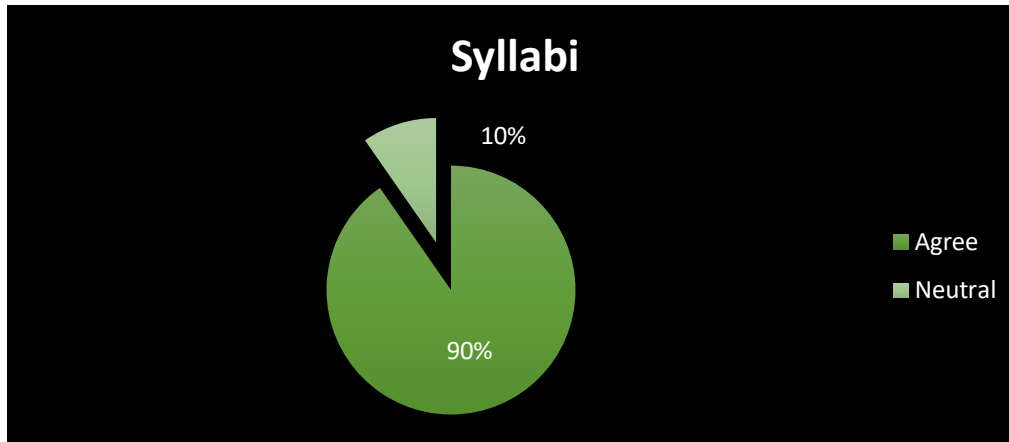

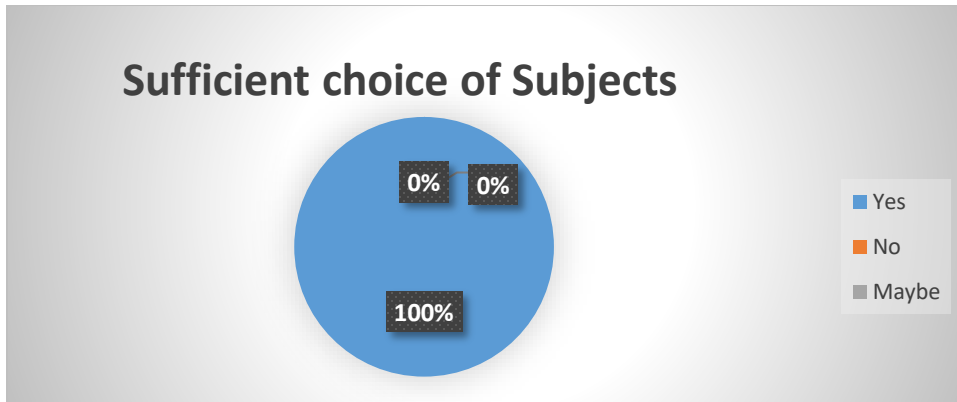
Student's Feedback on the Ambience of the College

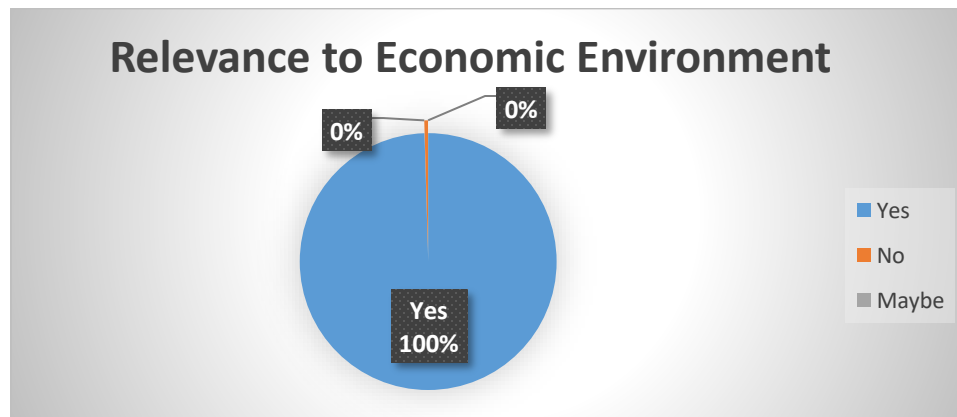


13. Feedback of S.Y.B.Com Students('D' Component)

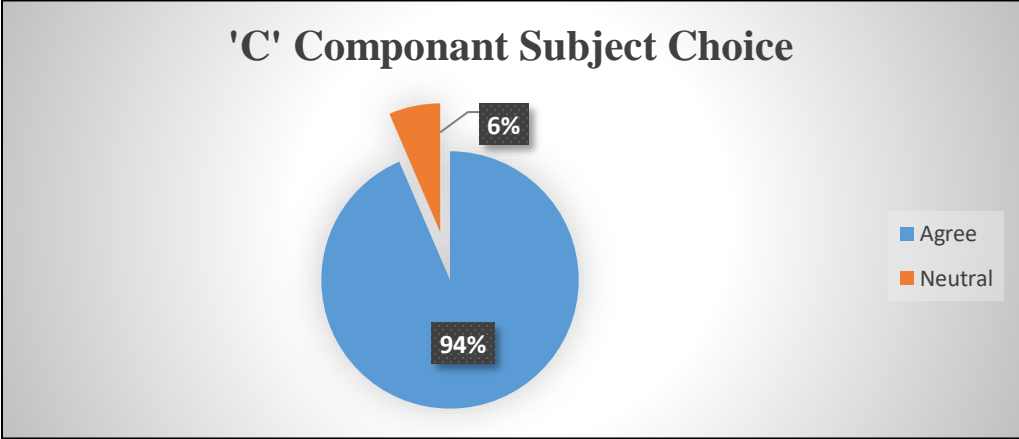

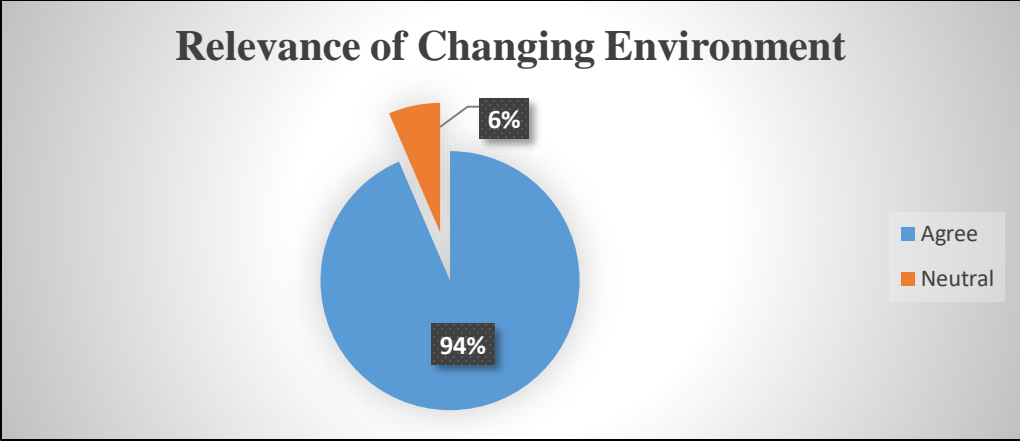
