This notice is being issued for Online Registration, Scanning & uploading of documents, Documents E-Verification and Online Application Form Confirmation, Filling & Confirmation of Option Form, Self-confirmation before seat acceptance, Paying seat acceptance fees in online mode for confirmation of admission, reporting to Institutes by candidates aspiring for admissions to First Year of Three/Four Year Full Time Under Graduate Course in BCA/BBA/BMS/BBM & First Year of Four Year Full Time Under Graduate Course in MBA (Integrated)/ MCA (Integrated). in the Government, Government Aided, University Managed, University Departments and Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions for the Academic Year 2024-25 in the Maharashtra State.

For the purpose of document verification, the concept of E-Scrutiny of the documents is introduced by the Competent Authority. The candidate shall choose E-Scrutiny mode for document verification during online form filling.

- 5. Candidates who have registered as a reserved category candidate but unable to produce required certificate for reservation claim during documents verification stage shall have to pay difference of fee of Rs. 200/- through online mode only.

- 6. Once the candidate confirms his/her Option form online through his/her Login for the respective admission rounds, Candidate will not be allowed to change/cancel the option/preference submitted under any circumstances.
